### MEMORANDUM FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

**TO: All Licensees, Temporary Licensees, and Applicants**  
**FROM: Kentucky Board of Prosthetics, Orthotics and Pedorthics**  
**RE: SB 150 State of Emergency**  
**DATE: May 26, 2020**

On March 26, 2020, the General Assembly enacted Senate Bill No. 150 which was signed by the Governor on March 30, 2020. The law became effective immediately. You can find a copy of the law at <https://apps.legislature.ky.gov/recorddocuments/bill/20RS/sb150/bill.pdf>. This bill allows boards to waive or suspend the fees or administrative obligations required to engage in business regulated by the board during the State of Emergency. The law provides that all current licenses remain in effect during the State of Emergency and all administrative requirements set forth in the statutes and regulations are stayed for 30 days after the State of Emergency is lifted. This includes all fees, fines, and renewal applications, and continuing education requirements.

The Board is mindful that it may be difficult to obtain the continuing education required by 201 KAR 44:060.
