68%

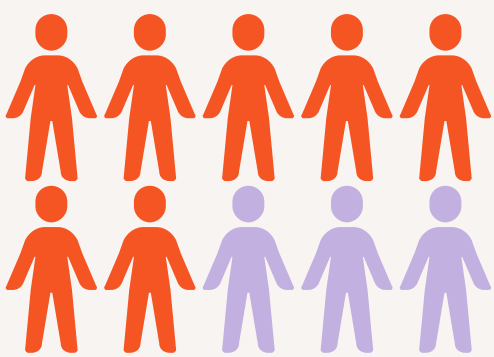
of respondents would feel comfortable working for an employer who they disagree with politically.

of respondents would not feel ashamed if their child doesn't share their political views.

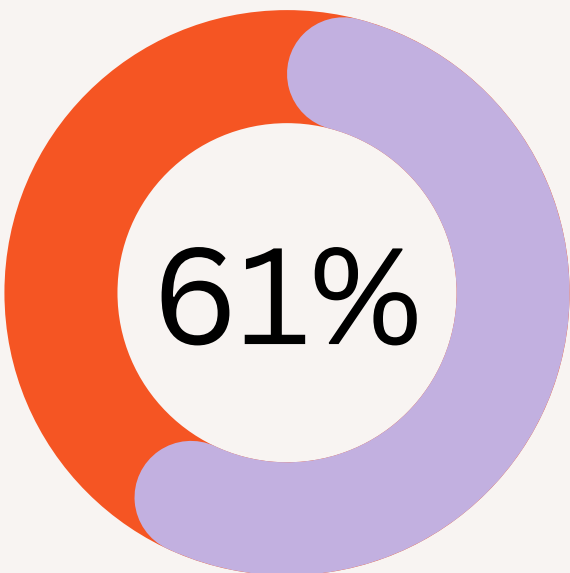
75%
