Re: COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive

The Commonwealth of Kentucky remains committed to limiting the spread of COVID-19 and ensuring the health and safety of our state employees through the "Healthy at Work" initiative. This includes encouraging participation in preventative vaccinations, which remain a critical component of containing and limiting the spread of COVID-19 related illnesses. In an initial effort to encourage vaccinations, on January 27, 2021, the Governor authorized the Personnel Cabinet to release Personnel Memo 21-02, which allowed Executive Branch employees to obtain the COVID-19 vaccine during scheduled work hours, and which granted leave for recuperation from any side effects. This was followed by Personnel Memo 21-12, on August 3, 2021, which allowed Executive Branch employees to use scheduled work hours to obtain a COVID-19 test.

As an additional effort to encourage voluntary participation and as authorized via Executive Order 2020-215, the Governor has announced that he is also awarding active, permanent, full-time, and part-time Executive Branch employees with one (1) day of annual leave upon submission of proof of receiving a COVID-19 vaccination (or first dose in a series) on or since December 1, 2020. At this time, the award is capped at one (1) day (i.e. the employee will not receive 2 days of leave for completion of a 2-shot vaccine series).
