EXECUTIVE ORDER 2020-01

APPROVAL OF PROCEDURES ESTABLISHED FOR ELECTION DURING STATE OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2020, pursuant to K.R.S. 39A.100(1)(1) as amended, the Secretary of State recommended to the Governor that he declare by executive order a different manner for the elections scheduled to be held on June 23, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2020, the Governor, by way of Executive Order 2020-296, accepted and incorporated therein the recommendation of the Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2020, the Kentucky State Board of Elections, pursuant to K.R.S. 39A.100(1)(1) as amended, voted to promulgate Emergency Administrative Regulation, 31 KAR 4:190E, Procedures for June 23, 2020 Elections, to establish procedures for election officials to follow for the June 23, 2020 elections, and such emergency administrative regulation has been signed by the Governor; and

WHEREAS, K.R.S. 39A.100(1)(1) as amended requires that, in order for such procedures to take effect, they be approved by executive order of the Secretary of State;

Adams, Secretary of State of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and its Chief Elections Official, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution of Kentucky and K.R.S. 39A.100(1)(l), do hereby approve the procedures established by the Kentucky State Board of Elections by way of Emergency Administrative Regulation, 31 KAR 4:190E, Procedures for June 23, 2020 Elections.
